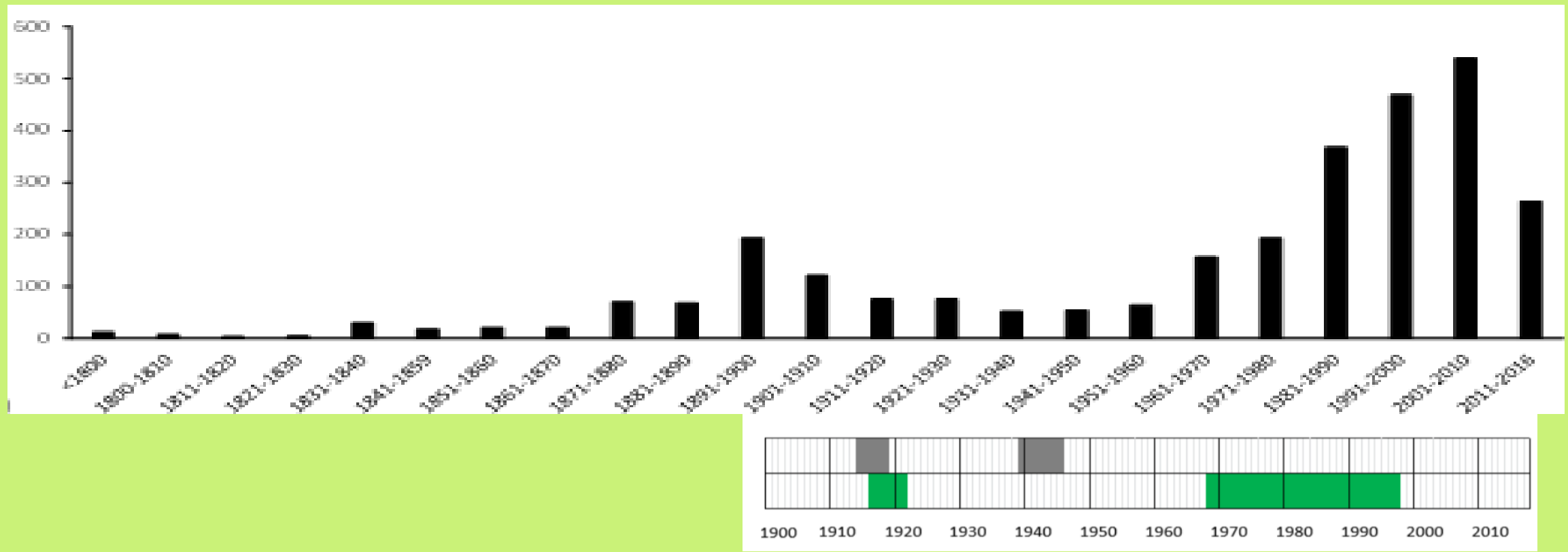

Put all contributions on wild mammals into historical timeline since 1800 -2016 by decade

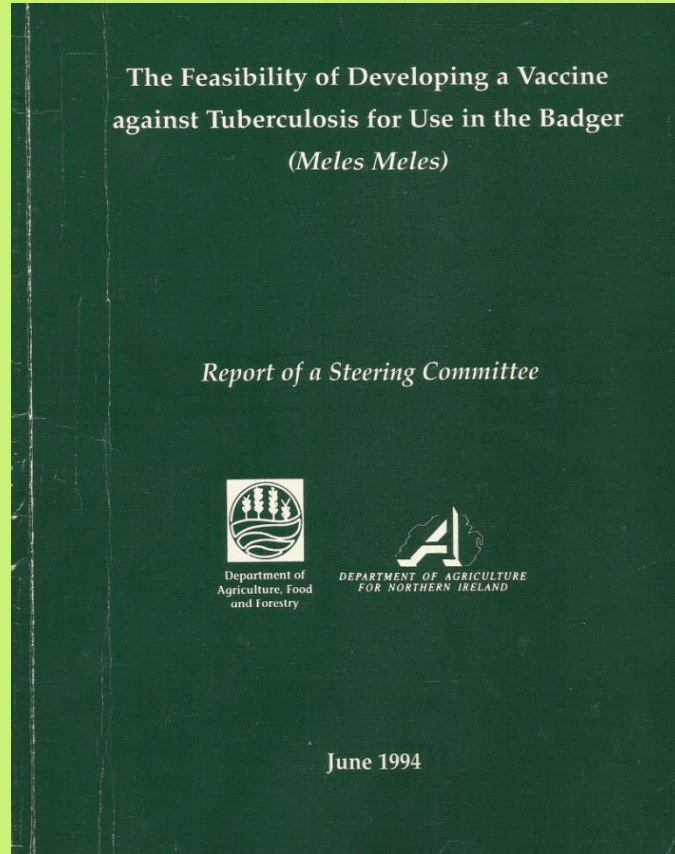


Put in historical context First Troubles 1916-1922, Second Troubles 1968-1998

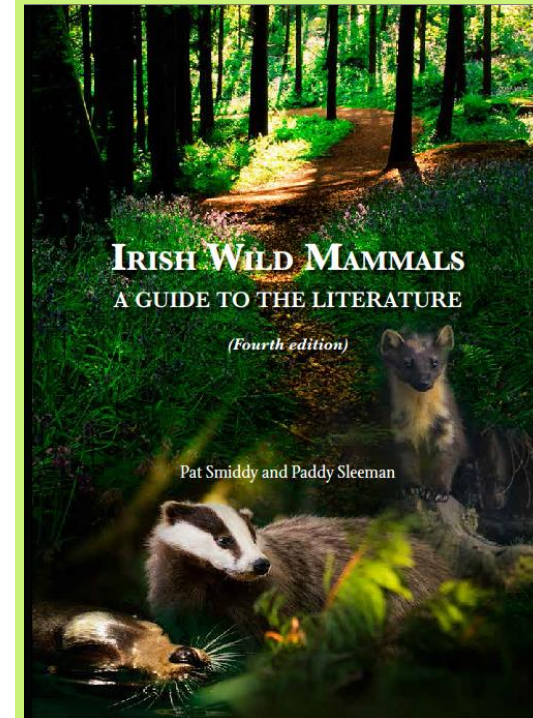
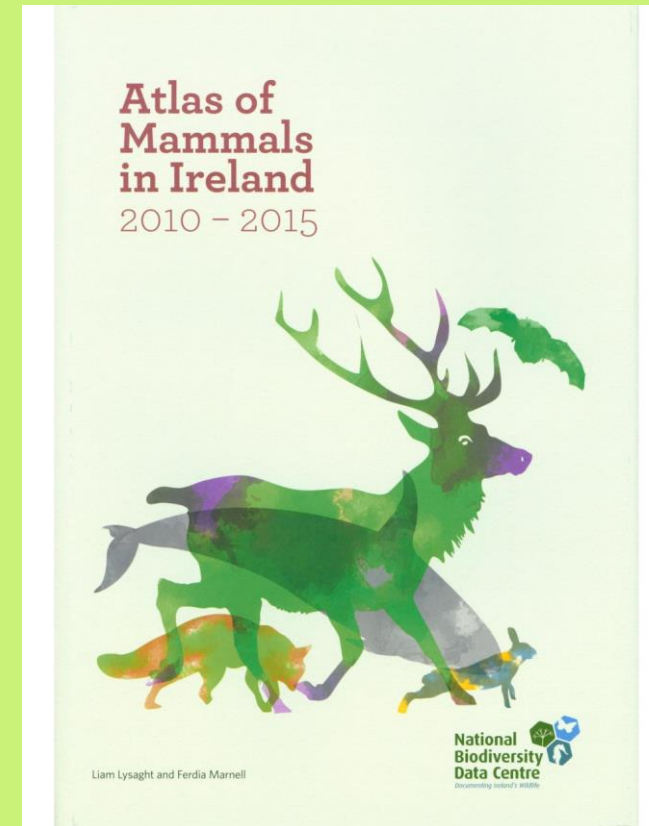
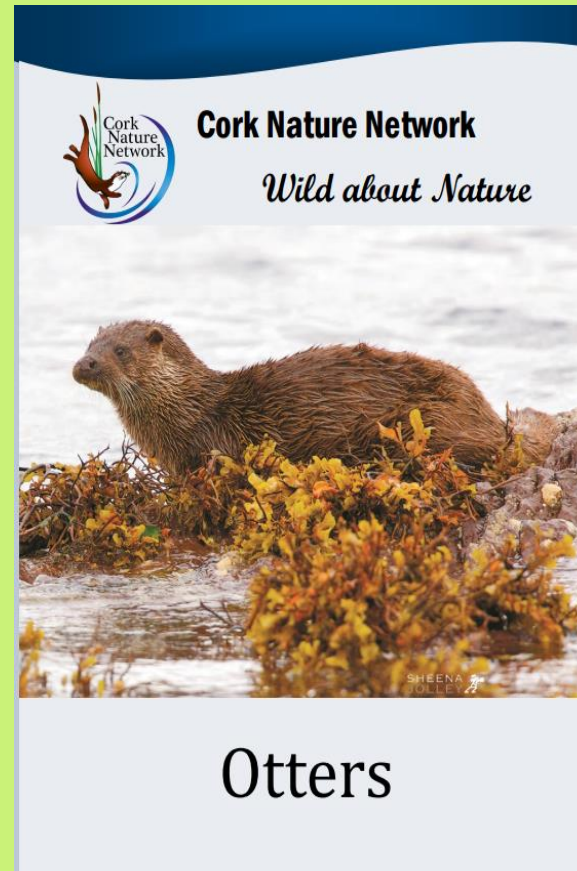
