To present a paper or poster, send the following details to students@themammalsociety.org with the subject "Student Conference Presentation/Poster [delete as appropriate]" by midnight on the 3rd of March 2018.

Offers of posters:

Please provide a three-point summary of the poster. Each point should be no longer than 25 words. Provide the title of the poster, the authors' names and addresses and a lead author e-mail. Abstracts are not required. An example template is provided, below.

Offers of papers:

An abstract is required. The submission should consist of the following formatted as 12-point font, Times New Roman style, single line spacing and full justification

- the title of the paper,
- the authors' names (author giving the paper should be underlined),
- affiliations and addresses,
- the e-mail address of the author giving paper
- an abstract of no more than 150 words
