## How to make a footprint tunnel

## What you will need

- Corrugated plastic or an old storage box
- A4 paper
- Paper fasteners
- Masking tape
- Shallow tray
- Paint brush
- Carbon powder
- Vegetable oil





Step one. Make a triangular tunnel with sides roughly 23cm. The tunnel needs to be 90cm long to hold 2 A4 sheets, plus space for ink and food. Secure the A4 sheets to the base of the tunnel at each end.

Step two. Put the tray filled with the bait in the centre. Completely cover the spaces between the paper and bait tray with masking tape strips. In a bowl, combine one part veg oil and one part carbon powder then mix well. Paint the mixture liberally onto the masking tape.





Step 3. Place the tunnel in a sheltered area of your garden and check the paper for mammal footprints each day.
